Program Overview



The purpose of the LIONS D.A.D.S. program is to provide an exclusive opportunity for fathers, grandfathers, or legal guardians of Hull Middle School students to become involved in supporting their child's academic success. Becoming a LIONS D.A.D.S. would mean being a positive role model to students within the school and performing various tasks throughout your volunteer day or hour. Your presence in the school not only supports your own child's success but will also support the success of students whose fathers or father figures are absent in the home.



How Does the LIONS D.A.D.S. Program Work?



Qualifications:

- The desire to help a Hull Middle child succeed
- Be a father, grandfather, or legal guardian of a currently enrolled (09-10) Hull Middle student.

Time Required

- Minimum of 2 hours per month

What will I be doing?

- Eating lunch with students,
- Helping to monitor lunch room
- Be a positive presence in the school
- Helping in classes with a teacher's guidance by working with pairs or small groups of students with homework, flashcards, talking in classes about life skills/ education.
- Helping in morning/afternoon car rider lanes (i.e. greet students, direct traffic)
- Greeting students morning/afternoon in bus lanes
- Showing your own child that you care to be there

Will I be trained?

Yes, you will receive a short training session which will familiarize you with the program and explain your role as a LIONS D.A.D.S.



Is there a cost?

Yes, besides the cost of your time, D.A.D.S. will be required to purchase a polo shirt to be worn during their volunteer time/day so that they can be easily recognized by students and staff members.
